ABBREVIATIONS

(anc.) from an ancient source which may or may not be in the Golic linguistic family
(IGV) used only in Insular Golic Vulcan (but occasionally as a synonym in TGV & MGV)
(LGV) used only in Lowlands Golic Vulcan (but occasionally as a synonym in TGV & MGV)
(MGV) used only in Modern Golic Vulcan
(NGS) a non-Golic word used by at least some Golic speakers
(obs.) considered obsolete to most speakers of Golic Vulcan, but still might be used in ceremonies, literature, etc.
(TGV) used only in Traditional Golic Vulcan
(VTW) a "Vulcanized" Terran word, used as is by Vulcans, often due to no corresponding word in TGV or MGV
 All other abbreviations are standard dictionary abbreviations.
