Phonetic spellings are provided for some of the words to assist in pronunciation. (Sorry, but this page may only display properly if your browser supports Unicode.)

ABBREVIATIONS

- (anc.)** from an ancient source which may or may not be in the Golic linguistic family
 - (IGV)** used only in Insular Golic Vulcan (but occasionally as a synonym in TGV & MGV)
 - (LGV)** used only in Lowlands Golic Vulcan (but occasionally as a synonym in TGV & MGV)
 - (MGV)** used only in Modern Golic Vulcan
 - (NGS)** a non-Golic word used by at least some Golic speakers
 - (obs.)** considered obsolete to most speakers of Golic Vulcan, but still might be used in ceremonies, literature, etc.
 - (TGV)** used only in Traditional Golic Vulcan
- All other abbreviations are standard dictionary abbreviations.
